

There's so much to learn about working with glass and so much to remember from classes. We thought some refreshers might be useful.



## DID YOU KNOW?

We have two Diamond Hone Blocks. They have three layers of diamonds and nickel bonded to a steel frame.

It has four sides with grits of 600 (fine), 400 (medium), 300 (coarse) and 200 (extra coarse).

**When to use:** We use this block to grind down glass when a flat surface is needed.

It is also used when a sharp point needs to be filed off etc. This is an easy way to fix a small problem without getting the big grinder out.



## How to use:

### Must Be Used Wet:

- Run water over grinding block.
- Place on a flat surface and move glass back and forth on grinder surface.
- Re-wet surface often.
- When finished take grinder out of black case and clean grinder under running water with a tooth brush.
- Dry grinder with a towel and set grinder on end on a paper towel to air dry completely. Just leave it out on the counter.
- Wipe dry the black case and place near grinder. The grinder will rust if not completely dry.
