There's so much to learn about working with glass and so much to remember from classes. We thought some refreshers might be useful.



## **DID YOU KNOW?**

The club has purchased new towels that are lint free or almost lint free. Use these towels only to clean and dry your fused glass projects only.

**Lint** can cause bubbles or imperfections in your project. Using the new lint free towels will help with this problem.

The **new towels** are located (yellow and white) under the sink. Use the tub marked fused glass to the right of the sink to deposit used towels. These towels will be washed separately from the old towels.

The **old towels** should be used for stained glass projects (dirty cleaning like flux, mudding, polishing creams, Patinas etc.).

The **old towels** are located in a white bin in cabinet #9 (bottom cabinet to the right of the sink). Use the tub on top of the cabinet to the right of the sink to deposit used towels. These towels will be washed separately from the yellow and white towels.

Please do not use towels to wipe off the tables. Doing so can embed glass shards into the towels.

As a reminder, when washing our towels please wash with soap only. Do not use fabric softener.

In dryer, do not use fabric sheets. Softener leaves a film on the glass.
