

## **DID YOU KNOW?**

The DATES on the fusing tickets are sometimes not filled out correctly. The date on the ticket should always be the date that the glass is placed on the shelf to be fired. If you fire your glass then add additional glass and want it fused again, always make a new ticket to reflect the current date.

Always make one ticket per glass project over 2" by 2". The only times you may put more than one item on a ticket is when fusing wind chimes (less than 1 inch wide), jewelry, ice sickles etc. The limit is <u>5 per slip</u>.

Reason: The kiln committee members put in large glass projects first then fill in the kiln with small items. Having small items on their own ticket allows us to maximize the space in our kilns. We also tract each piece of glass from start to finish. This ticket allows us to know who fired the glass and in what kiln. Some projects can be fired up to three times and the ticket must follow that one piece all the way to completion.

Please describe your project in detail. Example: writing only dichroic earrings is not enough. There are lots of dichroic earrings!! We need you to put the size, the colors, draw a picture if needed, whatever it takes to describe your glass. This will help match up the glass with the ticket. Keep in mind the person that loads and firers the kiln one day will not be removing the glass the next day.
