

Class Studio Guidelines for Reopening

- Remember to wear Protective Gear, **Mask, Eye Protection and Closed Toed Shoes**.
- Sign up for a 2-hour time slot before coming down to the studio. Go to www.SCOVGlassClub.weebly.com and look on the News page for the link to the schedule.
- You may sign up for 3, 2-hour time slots per week at this time.
- Always sign in as soon as you come in then, **wash your hands**.
- The studio has been setup for only 6 members to work in there at a time. Please stand where the happy face is taped to the table. A big red X will mark spots where you should not stand.
- You may bring a project down to be fired or pick something up without signing up for a time slot. Mask, eye protection and closed toe shoes are still required. Please do not stay in the studio longer than a couple of minutes. Please do not ask members to hand you your finished glass because you forgot to wear the right Protective Gear.
- No Level 2 Instructor Monitors will be on duty because of the social distance rule.
- All classes are suspended at this time. Please do not help another member unless you can explain it from a 6-foot distance.
- Level 2 instructor Monitors will not have the combination to the monitor cabinet to sell supplies.
- Supplies will be sold each Thursday from 4:00 to 5:00 by Nancy Jarvis our studio manager. Please remember to line up outside and social distance. Nancy will help one person at a time.
- The studio is closed from 4:00 to 5:30 each day so that the kilns may be loaded. Please do not ask to stay and work.
- Anything you touch in the studio you should clean. Spray counters, tools etc. with disinfectant and dry with paper towels only.
- Don't forget to **wash your hands when you leave**.
- Suggestions and feedback are welcome as we will need to report back to Mark Wade on how the reopening is working.
